

1984 Bar Examination Statistics

PREFATORY NOTES

A comparison of the above statistics with statistical tables for all American jurisdictions which have appeared annually in issues of *The Bar Examiner* indicates that a peak in the number of applicants annually may have been reached in 1983. The number of applicants for each of the last five years were: 1980—58,040; 1981—59,307; 1982—63,339; 1983—64,877; 1984—64,419. The percent of applicants passing the bar annually for the last five years was: 1980—67.1%; 1981—65.9%; 1982—65.2%; 1983—66.1% and

1984—64.5%. The number of applicants in California has a big impact on bar admission statistics. For several years before 1984 approximately 12,000 to 12,500 applicants took the California bar examination annually. The number of California applicants in 1984 was 10,712, a decrease of over 1,000.

Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination Statistics

Comment on the MPRE Statistics

The National Conference of Bar Examiners has administered the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) program for a period of five years beginning in 1980. By 1984 the program has been accepted and a passing MPRE score required for admission to the bar of twenty-nine jurisdictions. The program has been accepted by Louisiana to begin in 1985, making a total of thirty participating jurisdictions. The number of applicants in 1984 was 35,113, an increase of 2,711 over the number of applicants in 1983.

Each participating jurisdiction selects a passing MPRE scale score. The passing scores range

from 65 to 85.

The MPRE consists of fifty multiple-choice questions providing raw scores or number of correct answers on a range of 1 to 50. An adjustment is made in these scores for each form of the MPRE based on the difficulty of the particular form of the test. If it is more difficult than the base test, points are added to the applicant's raw score and if the test is easier than the base test, points are subtracted from the applicant's raw score. The resulting scores are then converted to a range of scaled scores from 50 to 150.
