REQUEST FORM**

After you have taken the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE), use this form to request to have your scores sent to boards of bar examiners (other than the one indicated on your answer sheet).

Additional MPRE score reports sent to individuals rather than a board of bar examiners will be stamped "unofficial." Check with the board in advance to verify whether an unofficial report is acceptable, and to determine what minimum scaled MPRE score has been established as a passing score.
