

## List of Optional Questions That Can Be Added to the Application

NCBE does not determine whether particular categories of information, such as citizenship, immigration status, or authorization to work in the United States, are relevant to character and fitness or eligibility for licensure. The following questions are optional and are included to support jurisdictions that request this information in accordance with their own rules, policies, and legal requirements. Each jurisdiction independently determines which information is requested and how it is considered.

### 1 (a). Citizenship
